Another fantastic product for breastfeeding mothers are these **Milkies Milk Trays**. Nursing mothers know how a freezer stocked with frozen breast milk feels kind of feels like hoarding gold! These little life-sustaining portions are so precious! If you frequently pump or you work outside the home, this freezing system will be a boon. As you can see, the system comes with two plastic trays where you can freeze 1 oz. servings into long blocks.



The plastic may look flimsy, but it is thick and solid and its flexibility allows you to pop the blocks out easily. This is medical-grade plastic and I highly doubt you'll ever have a problem with it cracking, even if it was dropped on the floor full of frozen milk. The beauty of having the milk frozen into long tubes is that they can fit into any bottle, regardless of the shape and size. You can easily drop them in by ounce and know exactly how much milk you will be thawing. One package contains two trays, offering the option to freeze 16 ounces of milk at once, and I've found that letting the milk thaw for just a minute on the counter makes them even easier to pop out.



I really love this milk freezing system because of its simplicity and small footprint. Because it is more shallow than an ice cube tray, it hardly takes up any space in my freezer, and the shapes it creates are so functional. I love how it is reusable, durable, and easy to clean. I am increasingly more and more impressed with all of the items that come from Fairhaven Health, and I can recommend every one of them!
